2019 Club Competition

Sunday, September 8th, 2019

Venue: Eclipse Gymnastics

A fun, relaxed event where your gymnast will perform their routines for family and friends with certificates, prizes and special appearances by our Competitive Gymstar and ALP gymnasts!

HOW DOES THE CLUB COMPETITION WORK?

This event aims to provide a goal for gymnasts to strive for in their classes, to let them experience a competition in the familiar environment of their own club and to give an opportunity for the gymnasts to perform in front of a crowd.

Gymnasts will perform the routines and skills they have been learning throughout the year and will be assessed with a “pass” or “try again” on each apparatus. If the gymnast receives a pass for every apparatus they will be awarded a levels badge for that level at the end of the competition. If the gymnast should receive a ‘Try Again’ for any apparatus, they will be re-assessed during class time in the following weeks and receive their levels badge when they have passed all of the apparatus. Class times will not change after the competition but gymnasts will start working on skills for their next level in their current class.

Listed below is the format the event will take for each level

Development 1 & Accelerated Development

The competition will be a participation event where gymnasts will receive a certificate and collect a sticker at each apparatus when they have performed their routine. Medals will not be awarded for placings. Participation medallions will be presented at the end of the competition.

Development 2 - 4

Gymnasts will compete against other gymnasts in the club at their level and will be assessed for their levels badge at the same time. Medals will be awarded for overall places, and participation medallions will be presented at the end of the competition.

Gymstar Development

Gymnasts will receive a certificate listing their best skill on each apparatus as well as the skill that they need to work on. This will give the gymnasts some feedback as to how their skills are progressing. Medals will be awarded for overall places, and participation medallions will be presented at the end of the competition.

UNIFORM OPTIONS

- Black crop top with silver swirl and shorts or leggings.
- Black, red or teal Eclipse leotard which can also be worn with shorts or leggings over the top.
- Girls in the Gymstar Development program also have the option of wearing the Gymstar leotard if they wish.
- Boys can wear navy or black shorts of their choice with the Eclipse boys singlet top.

** Please note that all shorts and leggings must be plain black with no names on the back.

Gymnasts should bring a jacket and tracksuit pants to keep them warm when they are not competing.

No uniform? No stress! We keep a certain amount of uniforms in stock which can be purchased from reception. If we don't have the size you're after we will place an order for you. **Uniform orders must be in by JULY 25TH** for them to arrive in time for the competition so please see us sooner rather than later to ensure you don't miss out!

HAIR

Long hair should be tied back neatly to be kept off the gymnasts face. A basic ponytail is absolutely perfect, but if you're feeling creative, buns and braids are more than welcome too. You can even find our Competitive Program competition hair style tutorial on our website if your gymnast wants to be just like the 'big girls'!

WHEN WILL WE FIND OUT OUR SESSION TIME?

Your child's competition session will run for approximately 2 hours and the time will be determined by the level in which your child will be competing. Once bookings are closed, we will organise the sessions based on the number of entries. You will receive your gymnast's session time 4 - 5 weeks out from the competition. Sessions generally run at approximately 8.30am, 11.00am or 2.00pm to give you a rough idea of when you may need to be at the gym.
